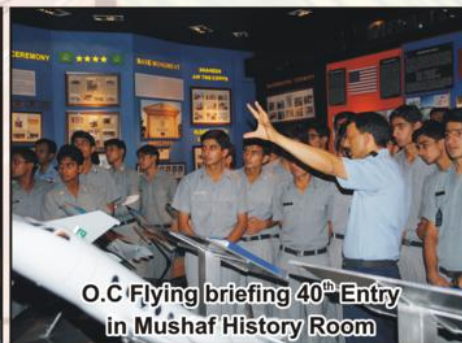

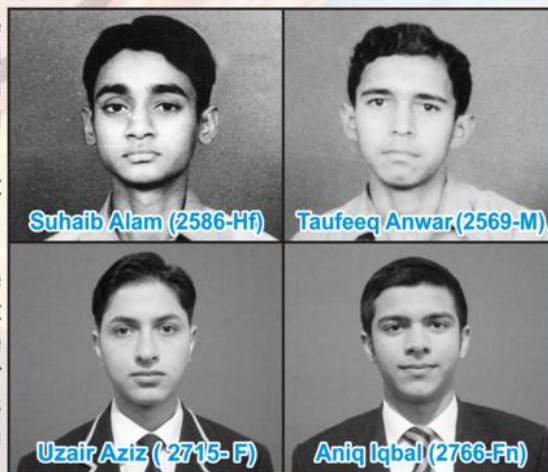
SARGODHIANS ATTENDED ACADEMY PASSING OUT PARADE AND GRADUATION CEREMONY
