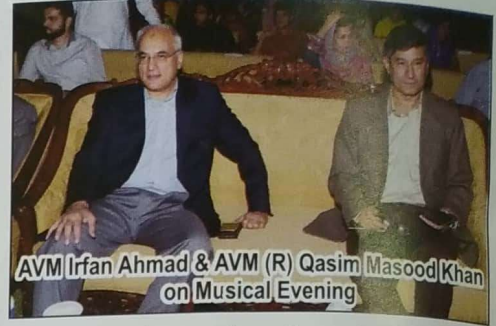
ABRAR UL HAQ IN THE COLLEGE

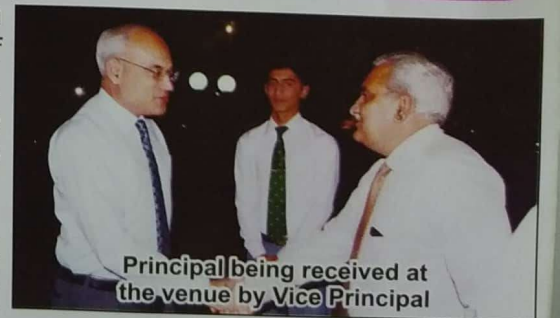


Principal presenting College Crest to Air Cdre (R) Shabbir A. Khan

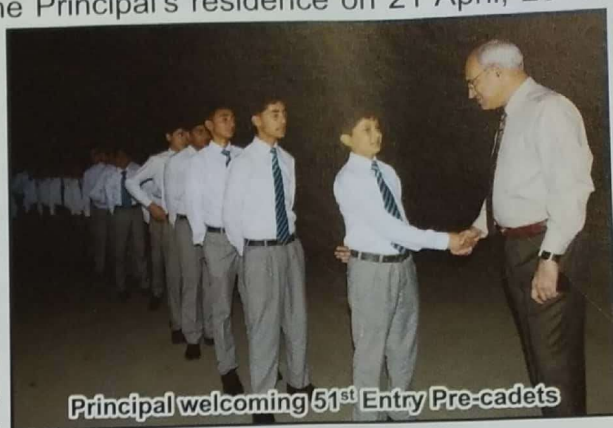
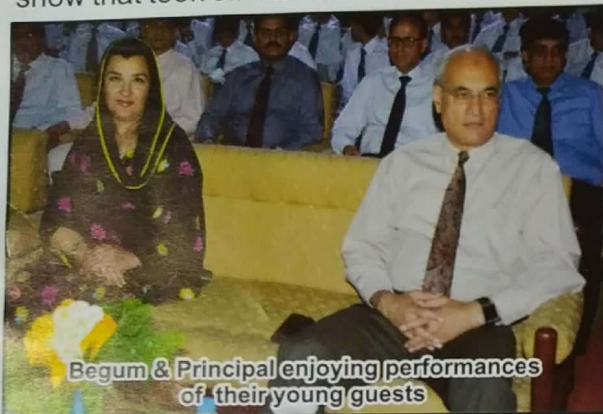

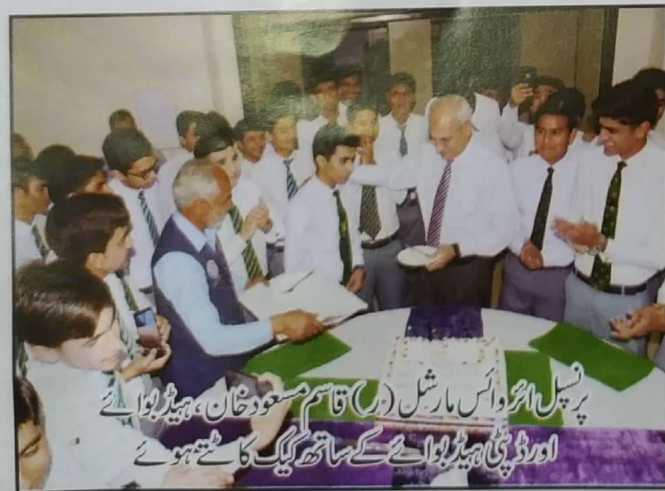
۴۶ ویں انٹری کا پانچ سالہ جشن
