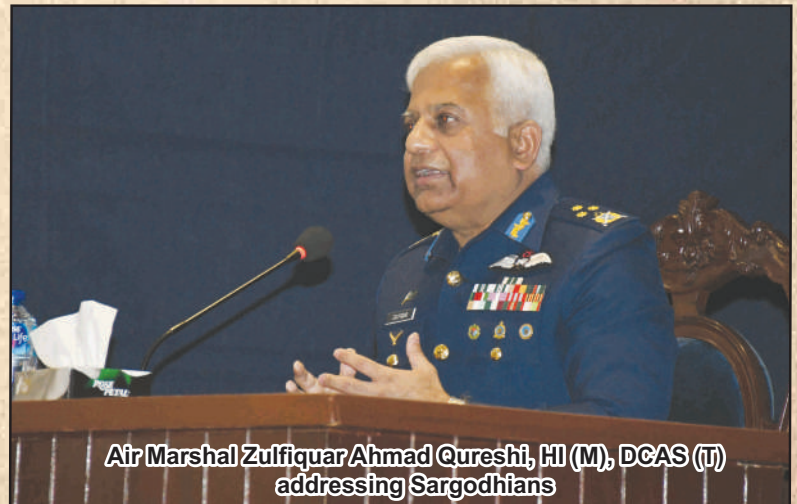

PAF College Sargodha takes immense pride in the fact that the Sargodhians produced the best ever result in all four Board exams held in 2021. Air Marshal Zulfiqar Ahmad Qureshi, HI (M), DCAS (Training) awarded laptops to the Entry toppers during his visit to the College on 01 December, 2021. M Abdullah (3637-M) from 49<sup>th</sup> Entry stood first securing 1100/1100 (100%) marks in HSSC (Composite) Board Exam. The entry's class average was an enviable 92.3%. From 50<sup>th</sup> Entry, Muhammad Bukhari (3687-M) stood first securing 519/520 (99.8%) marks in HSSC (Part-I) Board Exam. The entry secured an impressive class average of 90.2%. From 51<sup>st</sup> Entry, Shaheer Ahmad (3775-A) stood first securing 1100/1100 (100%) marks in their SSC (Composite) Board Exam. The class average of the entry was an incredible 98.2%. From 52<sup>nd</sup> Entry, Muhammad Rizwan (3884-A) and M Umer Usman (3910-I) shared the first position in SSC (Part-I) Board Exam securing 495/495 (100%) marks. The class average of the entry was an invincible 98.5 percent.

## A NEW PAGE IN THE HISTORY OF PAF COLLEGE SARGODHA

On 18 October, 2021, a rank ceremony was held in Rehman Auditorium on promotion of Group Captain Muhammad Shahid Hafeez to the present rank. Air Vice Marshal Imran Khalid, HI (M), (Retd), Principal, PAF College Sargodha and Begum Group Captain Shahid put on the ranks. It was a historic occasion for the College as it was the first ever promotion of a faculty member to the rank of Group Captain since its revival in 1990.

Group Captain Shahid joined the College on 15 March, 1992. During his career, the officer has held important assignments including Senior Housemaster, O i/c Sports, O i/c Hobbies Club, O i/c History Room, Head of Computer Deptt and Head of Sciences. He has to his credit, successful completion of innovative tasks like establishing the College History Room, commissioning of Computer Labs, and equipping all classrooms with multimedia. He was also an integral member of the team who revived PAF College Lower Topa in 1998. In recognition of his all-round meritorious services to PAF, the officer was awarded the Chief of Air Staff Commendation Certificate on 23 March, 2007.

In 2017, the officer was sent abroad by PAF to attend Masters in Educational Leadership course at the University of Manchester, UK. He proved his mettle by achieving 'Distinction' in the course. On his repatriation in 2018, the officer was tasked with training and grooming the young faculty at the College. The officer designed a customised Faculty Development Programme which broadly addressed major issues associated with teaching and mentorship. The programme has become a regular feature of the College, and is being conducted successfully on yearly basis. On 05 April, 2021, the officer was elevated to the prestigious post of Vice Principal, PAF College Sargodha.

Group Captain Shahid's promotion to the present rank not only acknowledges his commitment and dedication towards mentoring scores of Sargodhians, but also pays tribute to his outstanding professionalism and unflinching loyalty to the service. The Principal, officers, staff and pre-cadets of PAF College Sargodha convey their heartiest felicitations to Group Captain Shahid on his well deserved promotion.

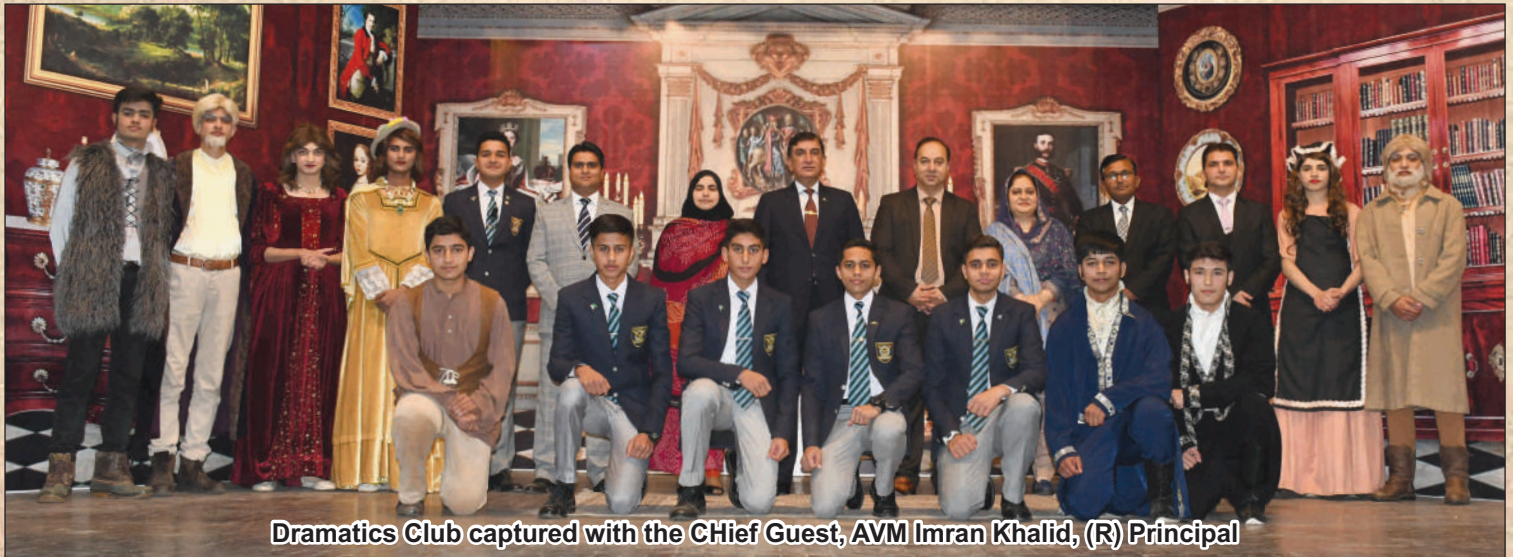
